Theo Sidiropoulos

(b.1924 – d.1998)

Theo Sidiropoulos was born in Katerini, Greece on 24 July 1924 and migrated to Australia in 1954.

He made outstanding contributions to Melbourne's social, political and civic life through his community and political activism, belief in social justice and support of migrants' rights. Theo was a community leader in Collingwood and the surrounding areas of Fitzroy, North Fitzroy, Clifton Hill, Abbotsford and Richmond, as well as within Melbourne's Greek Community. He also played a significant and visionary role at a State and national level.

Theo was:

- > Councillor, City of Collingwood (1968-1978)
- > Mayor City of Collingwood (1977)
- > MLA (Member of Legislative Assembly) for Richmond (1977-1988)
